Mairi Campbell is a pioneering figure in Scottish music. Her musical interests are wide ranging from playing Scottish dance music to pushing the boundaries of the tradition with her soundings and improvisations.

As a solo performer Mairi blends viola, voice and keyboard skills with a range of music that goes from traditional ballads to her unique soundings often with audience participation.

Mairi is a great interpreter of J.S Bach. She often plays unaccompanied Bach in her concerts.

Mairi has an improve string trio with Sua Lee, cellist in the Scottish Chamber Orchestra and Nicky Haire, violinist and music therapist. The three have an amazing musical chemistry. You have to hear it to believe it!

Sua and Nicky also play string support on Mairi's songs.

Mairi has built two solo music theatre shows 'Mairi Campbell : Pulse' (2016) and 'Mairi Campbell : Auld Lang Syne' (2018).
