Mairi's facilitation offers participants playful and profound encounters with their innate creativity and musical desires. Through the tools of InterPlay, choir leading, voice work, fiddle teaching and movement, Mairi is a sought-after teacher. She's taught across Scotland including Findhorn (EarthSings), Wellington, New Zealand (2019) and she was musical director and song arranger for Edinburgh's folk choir 'Sangstream' from 2003 to 2012. She wrote the arrangements and guided the direction of the choir. She has taught music camps in Canada, Germany and Denmark and collaborates with other tutors to offer unique and bijou creative courses. She also has a creative arts centre on the island of Lismore where she runs camps when she can.
